RESOLUTION NO. 82-23

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LODI
APPROVING THE APPLICATION FOR COMPOSTING GRANT FUNDS
UNDER THE SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT ACT OF 1980

WHEREAS, the Legislature of the State of California has enacted the State Solid Waste Management Act of 1980, which provides funds to certain entities for community recycling programs; and

WHEREAS, the State Solid Waste Management Board has the responsibility for the administration of the program setting up necessary procedures governing application for grant funds by local public and private entities; and

WHEREAS, the procedures established by the State solid Waste Management Board require all applications to include a certified minute order or resolution demonstrating local government sponsorship, identifying the project as a necessary component of the community's waste management system;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Lodi

1. Approves the filing of an application by California Waste Removal System, Inc., for funding under the State Solid Waste Management Act; and
2. Certifies that the Vegetative and Wood Waste Composting Project is a necessary component of the community's waste management system; and
3. Agrees to make/support efforts to successfully implement and sustain the recycling program and to consider any fiscal actions necessary to assure the program's continuation.
