

RESOLUTION NO. 2005-208

A RESOLUTION OF THE LODI CITY COUNCIL APPROVING AND
ADOPTING THE ESTABLISHED OVERALL ANNUAL DISADVANTAGED
BUSINESS ENTERPRISE GOAL OF 6% FOR FEDERAL TRANSIT
ADMINISTRATION-ASSISTED PROJECTS FOR FEDERAL
FISCAL YEAR 2005-06

WHEREAS, the City of Lodi is required to develop and submit an overall annual goal for Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) participation for U. S. Department of Transportation (DOT)-assisted contracts as a condition of federal financial assistance, pursuant to Title 49 CFR Part 26; *Participation by Disadvantaged Business Enterprises in Department of Transportation Programs*; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with DBE regulations, the City of Lodi has established an overall annual DBE goal for federal fiscal year 2005-06 for Federal Transit Administration (FTA)-assisted projects to ensure full compliance with relevant regulatory requirements; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lodi has established a goal of 6% for DOT-assisted projects for federal fiscal year 2005-06; and

WHEREAS, City Council adoption is required to ensure compliance with DOT's federal funding requirements, provisions, and financial responsibilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Lodi City Council does hereby authorize the approval and adoption of the established overall annual DBE goal of 6% for FTA-assisted projects for federal fiscal year 2005-06 and submission to the California Department of Transportation for funding authority approval on behalf of the City of Lodi.
