

RESOLUTION NO. 2536

WITHDRAWING CERTAIN PROPERTY ANNEXED
TO THE CITY OF LODI FROM THE WOODBRIDGE
RURAL COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT

WHEREAS, this City Council did by Ordinance No. **719**, effective **April 20, 1967**, approve the annexation of that certain real property, contiguous to the City of Lodi, designated as **"Estadale Addition"**; and

WHEREAS, there is on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Lodi the Certificate of the Secretary of State of the State of California, executed by said Secretary of State on **April 23, 1967**, referring to said Ordinance No. **719**, and the annexation of the real property described therein; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of this City Council that said property designated as **"Estadale Addition"** be withdrawn from the Woodbridge Rural County Fire Protection District; now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lodi as follows:


That that certain real property, designated as **"Estadale Addition"**, and particularly described as follows,

to wit:

1. portion of the Northeast Quarter of Section 10, Township 3 North, Range 6 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, San Joaquin County, California, and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the East line of Section 10, Township 3 North, Range 6 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, which point is 889 feet South of the Northeast corner of said Section, and which point is also a corner of the Lodi City Limits; thence North 89° 16' East along the North line of the Woodbridge Irrigation District

Local Right-of-Way, also a City Limit Line, 2,600.7 feet to the East line of Lower Sacramento Road; thence South along the East line of Lower Sacramento Road 491.85 feet to the Southwest corner of the property of Emma E. Bethlefsen, as shown on Record of Survey filed September 30, 1960 in Volume 5, page 145, Record of Surveys, San Joaquin County Records; thence South 69° 12' East along the South line of said property 2,600.95 feet to the East line of Section 10; thence Northerly 494.4 feet along said East line of Section 10 to the point of beginning, the area thus described containing 25.4 acres, more or less.
