

RESOLUTION NO. 2809

REQUESTING STATE DIVISION OF HIGHWAYS
TO CONDUCT A STUDY OF SOUTHERN PACIFIC
RAILROAD CROSSING AT STATE HIGHWAY 12
(KETTLEMAN LANE) IN THE CITY OF LODI

WHEREAS, the Southern Pacific Company railroad through the City of Lodi is one of the main lines of said railroad company and carries a tremendous amount of rail traffic; and

WHEREAS, such rail traffic causes delays in movement of motor vehicles on State Highway 12 (Kettleman Lane) at its crossing of the Southern Pacific Company right of way in the City of Lodi; and

WHEREAS, traffic on State Highway 12 has significantly increased within recent years; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Lodi has long been aware of the need for an underpass or overpass across the Southern Pacific Company's right of way at State Highway 12, or other area in the southerly limits of the City of Lodi; and

WHEREAS, a solution to the traffic problem caused by said railroad crossing at State Highway 12 has become necessary for the safety of the general public;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Lodi that the State of California, Department of Public Works, Division of Highways be and is hereby requested to conduct a feasibility study and report on the need for an overpass or underpass in the southerly limits of the City of Lodi across the Southern Pacific Company's right of way at State Highway 12.
