

RESOLUTION NO. 2906

AWARD - HAM LANE STORM DRAIN-MOKELUMNE RIVER
OUTFALL-UNIT NO. 2.

WHEREAS, in answer to notice duly published in accordance with law and the order of this City Council, sealed bids were received and publicly opened by the City Clerk of this City on January 4, 1966, for the installation of the Ham Lane Storm Drain-Mokelumne River Outfall-Unit No. 2 as described in the specifications therefor approved by this City Council on December 15, 1965; and
