

RESOLUTION NO. 3167

AWARD - GASOLINE. OILS AND GREASES

WHEREAS, in **answer** to notice duly published in accordance with **law** and the order of this City Council, sealed bids **were** received and publicly opened by the City Clerk of this City on March 4, 1968, for the furnishing of gasoline, oils and greases to the City of Lodi as described in the specifications therefor approved by the City Council on February 14, 1968; and

WHEREAS, said bids have been compared, checked **and** tabulated and a report thereof filed with the City Manager, totalling **as** follows:
