

RESOLUTION NO. 3247

AUTHORIZING ENTERING INTO AN AGREEMENT FOR
MUTUAL DAY-TO-DAY **FIRE** PROTECTION AID AND
DIRECTING EXECUTION THEREOF

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the City Council of the City of Lodi, County of **San** Joaquin, State of California, the public safety and welfare require the entering into of **an** agreement for mutual day-to-day fire protection aid with each of the other incorporated cities within the County of **San** Joaquin, State of California, with each of the fire districts of the County of **San** Joaquin, State of California, and with each of the **rural** county fire protection districts of the County of **San** Joaquin, State of California, whereby each of the cities and districts shall render aid each to the other to combat fire when such aid **is** necessary **on a** day-to-day basis; and

WHEREAS, the entering into of such agreement is authorized by the provisions of the "Joint Exercise of Powers Act," being sections 6500-6578, inclusive, of the Government Code:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lodi that **an** agreement for mutual day-to-day fire protection aid be entered into **as** aforesaid by the City of Lodi and that the Mayor **be** and is hereby authorized and directed to execute on behalf of the City the said Agreement for Mutual Day-to-Day Fire Protection Aid.
