A RESOLUTION OF THE LODI CITY COUNCIL ACCEPTING
GRANT FUNDS FROM THE BUREAU OF JUSTICE
ASSISTANCE TO SUPPORT TECHNOLOGY PROGRAM
ACTIVITIES WITHIN THE LODI POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the Lodi Police Department submitted a proposal for grant funding to the Bureau of Justice Assistance to support technology program activities; and

WHEREAS, the activities include replacement of computer hardware: Mobile Data Computers and associated software for patrol vehicles; replacement of in-house computer towers, servers, and external tape drives; Linksys wireless adapters; and radar unit replacement; and

WHEREAS, software purchases include yearly license fees for Microsoft Office Systems and suspect Image Database; and

WHEREAS, the Lodi Police Department was awarded the grant by the Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance in the amount of \$23,355.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Lodi City Council does hereby accept grant funds in the amount of \$23,355.00 from the Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance to support technology program activities as outlined above.


