

RESOLUTION NO. 2174

WITHDRAWING CERTAIN PROPERTY ANNEXED
TO THE CITY OF LODI FROM THE WOODBRIDGE
RURAL COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT

WHEREAS, this City Council did by Ordinance No. 621, effective September 6, 1958, approve the annexation of that certain real property, contiguous to the City of Lodi, designated as Becker Addition, and

WHEREAS, there is on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Lodi the Certificate of the Secretary of State of the State of California, executed by said Secretary of State on September 8, 1958, referring to said Ordinance No. 621 and the annexation of the real property described therein, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of this City Council that said property designated as Becker Addition be withdrawn from the Woodbridge Rural County Fire Protection District, now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LODI AS FOLLOWS:


That that certain real property designated as Becker Addition and particularly described as follows, to wit:

A portion of the Southwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 2, Township 3 North, Range 6 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian and more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the west line of Lot 26, Gerard Tract as filed for record August 8, 1916 in Volume 8, page 62, book of Maps and Plats, San Joaquin County Records, which point is 12 feet south of the Southwest corner of lot 19, Gerard Tract, and which point is also a corner of the present boundary of the City of Lodi; thence northerly along the West line of said Lots 26 and 19, 208.83 feet to the Northwest corner of Lot 19; thence easterly 621.9 feet along the north line of Lot 19 to the west line of Loma Drive, previously known as Lockeford Avenue; thence Southerly along the west line of Loma Drive 208.83 feet to a point 12 feet south of the south line of Lot 19; thence westerly along a line 12 feet south of and parallel to the south line of said Lot 19, which line is also a City boundary, 623.8 feet to the point of beginning; containing 2.97 acres, more or less.

annexed to the City of Lodi by council Ordinance No. 621, be and it is hereby declared to be withdrawn from the Woodbridge Rural County Fire Protection District.
