RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECTION  
OF SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS FOR STREET LIGHT  
CONSTRUCTION ON THE TOKAY STREET LIGHTING  
DISTRICT AND THE VINE-WINDSOR STREET LIGHT-  
ING DISTRICT BY THE COUNTY TAX COLLECTOR

RESOLVED, that all special assessments for street light construction in the Tokay Street Lighting District and the Vine-Windsor Street Lighting District which remain unpaid at the time of the adoption of this resolution shall be forwarded to the San Joaquin County Tax Collector with the request for their inclusion on the 1960-61 property tax rolls in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 18.1 of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California.

The description of the property to be assessed and the amount of the assessment together with interest thereon from the date of filing the original list of unpaid assessments and at the rate of one per cent (1%) per month to the next succeeding thirty-first day of December of the tax year for which such roll is being prepared, all as provided in Section 5451 of said Streets and Highways Code, is contained in a list hereto appended and made a part of this resolution.
