

RESOLUTION NO. 2488

DETERMINING THAT THE PORTION OF THE STREET WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS KNOWN AS REYNOLDS ROAD, PINKERTON AVENUE, CLUFF AVENUE, AND FLORAL AVENUE BE NAMED "CLUFF AVENUE"

WHEREAS, the City Planning Commission has recommended to the City Council of the City of Lodi that the portion of the street within the City Limits now known as Reynolds Road, Pinkerton Avenue, Cluff Avenue and Floral Avenue be named "Cluff Avenue"; and

WHEREAS, after public hearing thereon, the City Council finds there are no objections to the proposed street name change; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that the recommended change would be of benefit and convenience to the general public; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lodi that the portion of the street within the City Limits now known as Reynolds Road, Pinkerton Avenue, Cluff Avenue and Floral Avenue be and the same is hereby changed to "Cluff Avenue;"

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this resolution, duly certified and sealed, be filed with the County Recorder of San Joaquin County to accomplish the purpose hereof;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of this resolution be filed with the San Joaquin County Assessor, San Joaquin County Surveyor, Pacific Gas & Electric Company, Pacific Telephone & Telegraph Company, and the United States Post Office, Lodi, California\*
