

RESOLUTION NO. 2497

WHEREAS, the lack of improved sidewalks in the City of Lodi in many instances forces pedestrians, including school children, to walk in the streets and to be subjected to the hazards of vehicular traffic, and the lack of sidewalk during rainy weather has caused unhealthy conditions resulting from pedestrians walking through mud or water along streets or dirt sidewalks; and

WHEREAS, the lack of improved curbs and gutters in the City of Lodi permits poor drainage, puddles of water, the accumulation of filth, and subjects pedestrians and children in the normal sidewalk area to increased risk from accidental injury by vehicular traffic; and

WHEREAS, the lack of improved streets in the City of Lodi also permits poor drainage, puddles of water, the accumulation of filth and, in addition, impedes the operation of fire trucks, police cars and other emergency vehicles.

NOW **THEREFORE**, pursuant to the foregoing findings, the City Council of the City of Lodi does hereby adopt this Resolution as the basis and reason for the introduction and subsequent adoption of Ordinance No. 714 of the City of Lodi, adding Article V to Chapter 5 of the Lodi City Code, 1959.
