RESOLUTION NO. 1370

RESOLUTION STATING THE PURPOSE FOR WHICH  
CERTAIN LANDS WERE ACQUIRED BY THE CITY  
OF LODI AND DIRECTING THAT THEY BE PRE-  
PARED FOR SUCH USE.

WHEREAS, through proceedings initiated prior to the sixth day of  
May, 1947 and on payment of the sum of \$14,834.23 this City did acquire  
on the 10th day of September, 1947 from Fredrickson and Watson Const-  
ruction Company a certain forty acre parcel of land situated in Section  
31, Township 3 North, Range 7 East on Pearson Road about one-half mile  
East of State Highway 4 for the purposes of using the same and the  
excavation existing thereon as a place for the disposal of garbage  
and refuse by the method commonly known as " sanitary fill ", such  
purpose being the sole and only motive for such <sup>purchase</sup> ~~purpose~~, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that this City Council does hereby reaffirm its  
actions and intentions as to the use of said land and definitely  
states that this land and the excavation thereon are to be used for  
a public purpose, viz, for the purpose of disposing of garbage and  
refuse matter by the sanitary fill method and to that end, the  
Superintendent of Streets and the City Engineer are hereby directed  
to proceed with the development and improvement of said land to the  
end and purpose that garbage and refuse may be disposed of thereon in  
a clean and sanitary manner so that no nuisance is created thereby.
