
RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE MAKING OF AN APPLICATION
TO THE STATE BOARD OF HEALTH FOR A PERMIT TO USE
CERTAIN LANDS IN SECTION 31, T3N, R7E FOR THE
DISPOSAL OF GARBAGE AND REFUSE MATTER.

RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lodi, San Joaquin County, California, that pursuant to and subject to all the terms, conditions and provisions of the Public Health Act of the State of California, approved March 23, 1907 and all amendments thereto, application by this City be made to the State Board of Public Health of the State of California, for a permit to use, operate and maintain works and excavations together with such construction as may be necessary therefore, for the disposal of garbage and refuse matter by the "sanitary fill" method on a certain forty acre parcel of land located in Section 31, Township 3 North, Range 7 East, particularly described in the sheet next annexed and made part of this Resolution. The works and excavations so to be used are to serve the City of Lodi as its boundaries now exist and as said boundaries may be enlarged and changed from time to time by annexations of territory to said City.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor of said City of Lodi be and is hereby authorized and directed to cause the necessary data to be prepared and investigations to be made, and in the name of said City to sign and file such application with the State Board of Public Health.

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Passed and adopted at an adjourned regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Lodi on the 8th day of October, 1947.
