RESOLUTION NO. 1404

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING ELECTION PRECINCTS, DESIGNATING THE POLLING PLACES THEREOF, APPOINTING ELECTION OFFICERS AND FIXING THEIR COMPENSATION FOR THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION TO BE HELD TUESDAY, APRIL 15, 1948.

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of Section 907 of the elections Code of this State, a General Municipal Election is to be held and conducted in the City of Lodi on TUESDAY, the 13th day of April, 1948, for the purpose of electing two (2) City Councilmen for the full term of four years each, (the voters of this City having determined at a special election held March 9, 1948, that the City Clerk and the City Treasurer shall hereafter be appointed by the City Council), therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the following election precincts be established; that the polling places of said precincts be at the locations hereinafter designated and that the officers to conduct said election, (each being a registered elector in his respective precinct), and their compensation be as follows:

CONSOLIDATED VOTING PRECINCT "A", comprising San Joaquin County Precincts 1, 2, 3, and 23, and those parts of "Beckman Precinct", wherein the voters reside in "Sperry Addition", "Morenz Addition", "Woodlake Addition", "Ballentyne Addition" and "Lake Street Addition", and the polling place thereof shall be at San Joaquin County Building, 210 North Sacramento Street, and the officers to conduct said election in said precinct shall be:


The polls for said election shall be open from 7:00 A. M. to 7:00 P. M. on the day of this election.
