

RESOLUTION NO. 1444

RESOLUTION DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LODI TO VACATE THE ALLEY IN BLOCK 6, SUBDIVISION OF LOT NO. 2 OF BURR'S ADDITION TO LODI.

WHEREAS, that certain twenty foot wide alley delineated on the official map of "Burr's Addition to Lodi, Subdivision of Lot 2" as extending north and south through Block Six (6) does not now, has not, and will not serve any public purpose, and

WHEREAS, abutting property owners have requested that this alley be vacated and the City Planning Commission has so recommended, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that it is the intention of this City Council of the City of Lodi, hereby expressed, to vacate, close up and abandon said alley as a public street, way, or alley. Reference is hereby made to a map on file in the office of the City Clerk of this City for further particulars and greater certainty.

This City Council does hereby fix, and public notice whereof is hereby given, Wednesday, the 15th day of December, 1948, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock P. M. and the City Council Chambers, City Hall in the City of Lodi as the time and place when and where objections to the vacation of this alley will be received, heard and considered.


Upon the passage of this resolution, the Superintendent of Streets shall post, or cause to be posted, notices of such passage in the time, form and manner prescribed by law. The City Clerk shall cause a copy of this Resolution to be published one time in THE LODI TIMES prior to the date herein set for the hearing of objections.
