

RESOLUTION NO. 1510

DIRECTING EXECUTION OF QUIT CLAIM
DEEDS TO PORTIONS OF A VACATED
ALLEY IN BLOCK 6, "BURR'S ADDITION
TO LODI, SUBDIVISION LOT 2"

WHEREAS, this City Council did by its Ordinance No. 381, adopted January 5, 1949 after proceedings had in conformance with law, order the vacation of a certain twenty foot wide public alley in Block 6, "Burr's Addition to Lodi, Subdivision of Lot 2", a certified copy of which ordinance was recorded in the office of the County Recorder of San Joaquin County on February 7, 1949 in O.R. 1159/455, and

WHEREAS, abutting property owners have paid the cost and expense of the proceedings taken to vacate said alley and desire that the City of Lodi convey to each of them any right, title or interest that said City may have in said vacated alley, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that this City make, execute and deliver quit claims to those portions of said alley abutting on and adjoining their several properties, to wit:

To Samuel and Marie Miller, owners of Lots 11, 12 and 13 and the Northerly five (5) feet of Lot 10, all in said Block 6:


To Julius Weber, a single man, owner of the Westerly 56.15 feet of Lots 15, 16, 17 and the Northerly ten (10) feet of Lot 18, all in said Block 6:

To Church of God, Ministerial Association of Northern California, a corporation; owner of Lots 7, 8, 9, the Northerly 13 feet of Lot 6 and the Southerly twenty (20) feet of Lot 10; the Southerly fifteen (15) feet of Lot 18, all of Lots 19 and 20 and the Northerly thirteen (13) feet of Lot 21; the Northerly twelve (12) feet of Lot 23 and all of Lots 24, 25 and 26, all in said Block 6:

The Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute said quit claim deeds on behalf of this City and place the same of record in the office of the County Recorder of San Joaquin County.
