RESOLUTION NO. 1653

PROHIBITING THE PARKING OF VEHICLES ON A
PORTION OF STATE HIGHWAY 4 IN THE CITY OF
LODI.

WHEREAS, the parking of vehicles, either attended or unattended, opposite the junction of State Highway 24 with State Highway 4 is a source of danger and a frequent cause of accidents, therefore;

RESOLVED, that the parking or standing of vehicles, either attended or unattended, be, and the same is hereby prohibited at any time along the westerly line of State Highway 4 (Cherokee Lane), between the following described limits: The Northerly line of the alley between Railroad Avenue and a point one hundred ten (110) feet Northerly therefrom.

This Resolution shall not become effective until:


- (1) The same is approved in writing by the Department of Public Works, Division of Highways;
- (2) Signs indication " No Parking " have been erected at the Northerly and Southerly limits of the section of highway on which parking is hereby prohibited and the curb along said section has been properly marked in red in accordance with Section 472(a) of the Vehicle Code of this State.

Should the Department of Public Works, Division of Highways withdraw its approval of the limitation expressed herein, then the provisions of this Resolution shall cease to be effective thirty (30) days from and after the date of formal notice from said Department.
