RESOLUTION NO. 1880

WITHDRAWING CERTAIN PROPERTY ANNEXED
TO THE CITY OF LODI FROM THE WOODBRIDGE
RURAL COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT

WHEREAS, this City Council did by Ordinance No. 534, effective August 19, 1955, approve the annexation of that certain real property, contiguous to the City of Lodi, designated as Willow Glen Addition, and

WHEREAS, there is on file in the office of the City Clerk of the City of Lodi the Certificate of the Secretary of State of the State of California, executed by said Secretary of State on August 22, 1955, referring to said Ordinance No. 534, and the annexation of the real property described therein, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of this City Council that said property designated as Willow Glen Addition be withdrawn from the Woodbridge Rural County Fire Protection District, now therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LODI AS FOLLOWS:


That that certain real property, designated as Willow Glen Addition, and particularly described as follows, to wit:

A portion of the Southeast Quarter of Section 35, Township 4 North, Range 6 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, and more particularly described as follows:

Commencing at a point on the present boundary line of the City of Lodi 1177.8 feet easterly and 30 feet northerly from the Southwest Corner of said Southeast Quarter, which point is also on the North line of Turner Road (Woodbridge Road), and running North 2195 feet, more or less, to the South bank of the Mokelumne River; thence meandering along the South bank of said River in an easterly direction, upstream, to a corner of the present City boundary line; thence southerly along said City boundary line 1851 feet, more or less, to a corner of said City boundary line, which point also lies on the North line of said Turner Road; thence westerly along said North line and City boundary line to the point of beginning, containing 49.3 acres more or less.
