RESOLUTION NO. 1920

DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF LODI TO VACATE A PORTION OF
THE STREET AT THE CORNER OF TURNER ROAD AND
MILLS AVENUE

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lodi
as follows:

Section 1. It is the intention of the City Council of
the City of Lodi, acting in accordance with the provisions
of Part 3 of Division 9 of the Streets and Highways Code of
the State of California, to vacate, close, and abandon as
public street the following street situated in the City of
Lodi, County of San Joaquin, State of California, more par-
ticularly described as follows:

A portion of the Northeast Quarter of Section 3,
T3N, R6E, M.D.B. & M., described as follows:

Beginning at a point which bears South 00°
0' 20" West a distance of 245.83 feet from the
Northeast corner of said Section 3, said point
being on the West line of Gerard Tract as filed
on August 8, 1916, in Book of Maps, Vol. 8, Page
62, Official Records, San Joaquin County, California;
thence North 58° 15' 08" West a distance of 45.50
feet to the true point of beginning; thence along
a curve to the right having radius of 2954.82 feet
and a long chord of 220.95 feet which bears North
55° 40' 42" West, said curve also being concentric
with and 60 feet distant from the Southerly line
of the Southern Pacific Company right of way; thence
South 72° 44' East a distance of 82.36 feet; thence


along a curve to the right to the true point of beginning, said curve having a radius of 160.00 feet and a long chord of 144.25 feet which bears South 46° 02' 11" East.

Section 2. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that this City Council does hereby fix WEDNESDAY, MAY 16, 1956, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock p.m. and the CITY COUNCIL CHAMBERS, CITY HALL, LODI, CALIFORNIA, as the time and place when and where all persons interested in or objecting to the vacation herein proposed may appear before this City Council and be heard.

Section 3. Upon adoption of this resolution the Superintendent of Streets shall post, or cause to be posted, notice of such passage and of the time and place set herein for public hearing, in accordance with and in time, form and manner as prescribed by law for the vacation of public streets.

Section 4. This resolution shall be published one time in the "Lodi News-Sentinel", a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the City of Lodi, said publication to be completed at least 15 days prior to said hearing.

Certified to be a full, true and correct copy of Resolution No. 1920 as passed and adopted by the City Council of the City of Lodi in adjourned meeting held April 17, 1956.
