RESOLUTION NO. 2005

A RESOLUTION ADVOCATING THE ESTABLISHMENT  
OF A REGIONAL PLANNING ASSOCIATION

WHEREAS, a Central Valley Regional Planning Conference was held in Modesto in October, 1956, such conference being participated in by representatives from the various cities and counties of the Central Valley, and

WHEREAS, one of the basic conclusions of this conference was that there is need to promote better planning within this region and need for greater coordination among cities, counties, the State, Federal agencies, and other groups, and

WHEREAS, the tremendous urban population growth of California points up the need for studies of the physical development of the State which are regional in nature and beyond the ability of any one city or county to plan, and

WHEREAS, many agencies of the State and Federal Government are making plans for important developments which are regional in nature, and

WHEREAS, certain regional and local studies must be coordinated before local city and county plans can be completed,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Lodi as follows:

1. That a Central Valley Regional Planning Association should be formed as soon as possible;
2. That the purpose of the association be to foster regional planning and to assist in the coordination of regional planning activities;
3. That the membership of this association be composed of designated members of local Boards of Supervisors, City Councils, planning commissioners, other designated public officials, and citizens from the cities and counties in the Central Valley watershed;


4. That meetings of the association be held not less than once a year;
5. That the Central Valley be divided into sections composed of the Sacramento Valley and the San Joaquin Valley with section meetings to be held as deemed needed by the membership;
6. That the Association and Sections elect officers and establish by-laws under which to operate, realizing that the Association would be an advisory agency only; and
7. That the Association study the need for the establishment of a Regional Planning Commission in accordance with Sections 65060 through 65072 of the California Government Code.
