RESOLUTION NO. 2023

ESTABLISHING A WHITE LOADING ZONE ADJACENT
TO THE LODI FUNERAL HOME PROPERTY

WHEREAS, the parking of automobiles in the 15-foot parking stall on South School Street between two driveways of the Lodi Funeral Home parking lot has frequently prevented entrance to or egress from said parking lot; and

WHEREAS, the Lodi Funeral Home, due to the above mentioned circumstances, requests that said parking stall be converted to a passenger loading zone; and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer states that said 15-foot parking stall is insufficient for proper parking and recommends that the request for a passenger loading zone be granted; now therefore,


BE IT RESOLVED, that the 15-foot parking stall adjacent to the Lodi Funeral Home property be and the same is hereby designated a passenger loading zone, and the City Engineer is hereby directed to place the necessary curb marking in accordance with Section 141.3 of Ordinance No. 493, as amended.
