

RESOLUTION NO. 2081A RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO MAKE CHANGES AND
MODIFICATIONS

PARKING DISTRICT NO. 1

RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Lodi, California, that the public interest and convenience require and it is the intention of said Council to make eliminations, changes and modifications in the acquisitions and improvements to be made pursuant to Resolution of Intention No. 1944 adopted July 18, 1956, as amended, as follows:

1. Eliminate, change and modify the acquisitions proposed to be made to provide for the acquisition of the following described parcels for parking places in lieu of those described in said Resolution of Intention as amended:

<u>Parcel C.1.</u>	Lot 8 and West 60 feet of Lot 7, Block 11;
<u>Parcel C.2.</u>	East 20 feet of Lot 7 and West 70 feet of Lot 6, Block 11;
<u>Parcel F.</u>	Lot 1 and West 30 feet of Lot 2, Block 9;
<u>Parcel H.</u>	Lot 7, Block 9;
<u>Parcel I.</u>	Lot 8 and West 40 feet of Lot 7, Block 8;
<u>Parcel K.</u>	Lot 2, Block 8;

all as shown on the map entitled "Mokelumne" (now City of Lodi) filed for record August 25, 1869 in Book of maps and plats Vol. 2, page 12, San Joaquin County Records.

2. Eliminate, change and modify the improvements to be made by providing for the improving of said parking places by grading and the construction thereof of pavement, curbs, drains, lights, fences, rails, meters and any building or structures necessary for the proper operation thereof and the making of all acquisitions and the constructing of all improvements and the performance of all work auxiliary thereto and necessary to complete same as off-street parking facilities. Said improvements may be constructed

by the City or acquired as constructed.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Wednesday, the 5th day of February, 1958, at the hour of 8:00 o'clock P.M. at the Council Chambers, City Hall, Lodi, California, are hereby fixed as the time and place when and where the Council will consider the matter of making said eliminations, changes and modifications. Any person interested and objecting to the making of said eliminations, changes and modifications may file a written protest with the City Clerk at the City Hall, Lodi, California, at any time prior to the hour set for hearing them.

The City Clerk shall give notice of the adoption of this resolution and of the City Council's intention to make said eliminations, changes and modifications and of said hearing by publishing a copy of this resolution twice, once a week for two (2) successive weeks, in the Lodi News-Sentinel, a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in said City, and the newspaper in which said Resolution of Intention was published, the first of which publications shall be not less than twenty (20) days prior to the date of said hearing.

Reference is made to the Second Supplemental Report of Pacific Planning & Research, formerly Harold F. Wise, Associates, to be made and filed in the office of the City Clerk, for the effect of said proposed eliminations, changes and modifications on the estimates and other data given in the original report on file in the office of said City Clerk.
