RESOLUTION URGING RELOCATION AND CONSTRUCTION
OF STATE HIGHWAY 12 FROM THE RIO VISTA BRIDGE
TO THE MOKELUMNE RIVER

WHEREAS, this City Council of the City of Lodi is informed that the Division of Highways, Department of Public Works, has surveyed and obtained rights of way for the relocation and reconstruction of State Highway 12 from the Rio Vista Bridgehead on Brannan Island directly east to the Mokelumne River Bridge and said project is ready for construction whenever money is allocated and budgeted therefor; and

WHEREAS, said highway route provides the most direct route to the Bay Area and the Redwood Highway for this District;


