RESOLUTION NO. 1142

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A SALARY AND WAGE PLAN
FOR THE CLASSIFIED EMPLOYEES OF THE CITY OF
LODI AND FIXING THE AMOUNT OF WAGE AND/OR SALARY
TO BE PAID TO CERTAIN EMPLOYEES NAMED THEREIN.

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (e) of Section 4 of Ordinance No. 276, the Personnel Clerk has prepared and submitted a "Salary and Wage Plan" for consideration by this City Council and by the Board of Trustees of Lodi Public Library, and,

WHEREAS, this City Council after due deliberation, finds and determines that certain alterations should be made in the said plan as submitted, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that from and after the first day of September, 1942, the minimum and maximum salaries and wages fixed by the City of Lodi in the following named positions in the classified service shall be as hereinafter stated, furthermore,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the compensation paid the hereinafter specifically named employees of this City, from and after the first day of September, 1942 shall be the monthly wage set opposite their respective names.

The said minimum and maximum amounts of salaries and wages and the said specific amounts of wages to be paid the employees named herein to be subject to such changes as this City Council may, from time to time, by resolution make in the said minimum and maximum amounts and in the monthly wages to be paid said named employees.


