



RESOLUTION NO. 1144.

BE IT RESOLVED, By the City Council of the City of Lodi, San Joaquin County, California, at a regular meeting of said City Council duly and regularly held this 2nd day of September 1942, that said City of Lodi shall enter into a contract with Foster & Wood Canning Company, a corporation, granting to said corporation the right to discharge into said city's storm sewers certain "screened cannery waste" for the term and under the conditions and subject to the restrictions contained in the said contract, copy of which was submitted to said City Council at said meeting and that C. B. Bull, Mayor of said city, for and on behalf of said city, is authorized to sign the said contract and J. F. Blakely, clerk of said city for and on behalf of said city, is authorized to attest the said contract, in the words, figures and form as so submitted; and that said contract shall be so made, executed and delivered for and on behalf of said city.


