RESOLUTION NO. **1190**

**RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING ELECTION PRECINCTS, DESIGNATING THE POLLING PLACES THEREOF AND APPOINTING ELECTION OFFICERS AND FIXING THEIR COMPENSATION FOR THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION, TO BE HELD TUESDAY, APRIL 11, 1944.**

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 9705 of the Elections Code of the State of California, a general municipal election is to be held and conducted in the City of Lodi on Tuesday, the 11th day of April, 1944, for the purpose of electing two (2) City Councilmen each for a full term of four years, a City Treasurer for a full term of four years, a City Clerk for a full term of four years and for voting on the following two propositions:

"Shall the City Council of the City of Lodi hereafter appoint the City Clerk of said City?"

"Shall the City Council of the City of Lodi hereafter appoint the City Treasurer of said City?"

BE IT RESOLVED, that the following election precinct be established; that the polling places for each of said precincts be at the locations hereinafter designated and that the officers to conduct the said election, (each being a registered elector in his respective precinct), and their compensation therefore, be as follows:

CONSOLIDATED VOTING PRECINCT "A" comprising San Joaquin County Precincts 1, 2 and 3 and the polling place thereof shall be at San Joaquin County Building, 210 North Sacramento Street, and the officers to conduct the said election in said precinct shall be:

Each of said officers of election shall receive the sum of Six Dollars (\$ 6.00) for the performance of all duties in said election.


The polls for this election shall be open from 7:00 AM to 7:00 P.M. (Pacific War Time) of the day of election.
