RESOLUTION NO. 1298

RESOLUTION DIRECTING TRANSFER OF FUNDS IN  
THE CITY TREASURY TO EXPEDITE CONSTRUCTION  
OF CERTAIN URGENT PUBLIC WORK PROJECTS.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Resolutions Nos. 1298 and 1292 adopted by this City Council on December 4, 1946, agreements have been made and entered into by and between this City and J.L. Webster, as contractor for the laying of certain pipe lines on this City's main line sewer outfall and with Homer Wright for the digging of pipe line trenches on both the Sacramento Street industrial waste drain and on the main line sewer outfall, both urgent public works necessary to the preservation of the public health undertaken by this City after proper proceedings and advertisement for bids and the rejection of the same, and,

WHEREAS, both of the above named Webster and Wright will have to have work progress payments made in order to meet payrolls and to pay for materials to be incorporated in or consumed on these projects,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the sum of TEN THOUSAND DOLLARS \* \* \* \* \* \$10,000.00 be and the same is ordered transferred from General Fund to the City Clerk's Revolving Fund for expenditure on proper certificates signed by the City Engineer that acceptable work has been performed and that certain amounts are due said contractors at the date of said certificate or certificates.

Proper vouchers covering each expenditure shall be submitted this City Council for allowance and approval at its next meeting after payment of any amount hereunder.
