

WHEREAS, Eugenie R. Robinett, A. M. Tower, C. J. Weber, F. A. Dougherty, and Edward Hutchins, have offered to convey to the City of Lodi, certain strips of land which are necessary for the extension of Pleasant and Lee Avenues.

Robinett, \$ 1150.⁰⁰, A. M. Tower, \$ 102.⁰⁰, C. J. Weber, \$ 1050.⁰⁰, F. A. Dougherty, \$ 200.⁰⁰, and Edward Hutchins, \$ 125.⁰⁰.

And Further, that upon presentation of deeds from said parties, conveying said strip of land to the City of Lodi, with good, merchantable title, that warrants be drawn to the respective parties, in the respective amounts, payable out of the general fund.
