

## RESOLUTION OF INTENTION NO. 19

RESOLVED THAT IT IS THE INTENTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE CITY OF LODI, IN THE COUNTY OF SAN JOAQUIN, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, TO ORDER THE FOLLOWING WORK TO BE DONE AND IMPROVEMENT TO BE MADE IN SAID CITY OF LODI, TO-WIT:

That Locust Street, in said City, from the East line of Hutchins Street to the West line of School Street, and from the East line of School Street to the West line of Sacramento Street, and from the East line of Sacramento Street to the East City Limits, being the West line of Cherokee Lane.

**BE IMPROVED:**

(1) By grading the roadway and curb and gutter spaces of said Locust Street.

(2) By constructing hydraulic concrete curbs and gutters of the combined type along each side of the roadway of said Locust Street.

(3) By paving the roadway of said Locust Street, between the gutter lines, with a pavement consisting of one and one-half (1½) inches of Warrenite Wearing Surface, laid on an asphaltic concrete base two and one-half (2½) inches in thickness.

(4) By constructing sidewalk approaches to each of the East and West curbs on each of the intersections of said Locust Street with Pleasant Avenue, Church Street, Main Street, Stockton Street, Cherokee Street, Grand Avenue and Garfield Street, and on the opposite termination of Lee Avenue where Lee Avenue terminates into Locust Street.

EXCEPTING, however, from all of the hereinabove described work such portion as is required by law to be kept in order or repair by any person or company having railroad tracks thereon; and excepting also from all of the hereinabove described work any of said work already done to the official grade.

All of said work shall be done in accordance with the plans and specifications heretofore adopted for doing said work and now on file in the office of the City Clerk of said City of Lodi.

Attention is also called to the Warrenite License Mixture Agreement for California, executed by Warren Brothers Company, the owner and holder of the patents and processes covering the said Warrenite pavement, which agreement is on file in the office of the City Clerk, and is hereby expressly referred to for greater certainty.

And said Board of Trustees does hereby determine and declare that said proposed work and improvement is of more than local or ordinary public benefit, and will affect and benefit the lands and district hereinafter described, which said district is hereby declared to be the district benefited by said work and improvement, and to have the exterior boundaries hereinafter described as the boundaries thereof; that therefore, the entire cost and expenses of said work and improvement shall be, and are hereby made, chargeable against, and shall be assessed upon said lands and district, which district is within the City of Lodi, County of San Joaquin, State of California, and is particularly bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at a point on the East line of Hutchins Street where a line parallel to and 170 feet North of the North line of Locust Street would intersect said East line of Hutchins Street, and running thence Easterly on and along said parallel line and distant 170 feet North of the North line of Locust Street to the intersection of the East line of Cherokee Street with the South line of the alley running East and West between Locust Street and Lockeford Street; thence continuing Easterly on and along the said South line of said alley to the intersection of said South line of said alley with the East City limits of said City of Lodi, being the West line of Cherokee Lane; thence Southerly on and along said East City limits of said City of Lodi, to the point of intersection of said East City limits with the North line of the alley running East and West between Elm Street and Locust Street; thence Westerly on and along the said North line of said alley to its intersection with the West line of Cherokee Street; thence continuing Westerly on and along a line parallel with and 170 feet South of the South line of Locust Street to the point of intersection of said parallel line with the East line of Hutchins Street; thence Northerly on and along said East line of Hutchins Street to the point of beginning; provided, nevertheless that the streets, avenues and alleys situate within said district shall be omitted from any assessment made or levied for paying the costs and expenses of the above mentioned work and improvement, the said streets, avenues and alleys belonging to said city, and being in use for the performance of a public function, to-wit, in use as public streets, avenues and alleys.

The extent of the territory to be included in said assessment district is indicated by a boundary line upon a diagram entitled "Diagram Indicating by Boundary Line the Extent of Territory to be Included in the Dis-

trict to be Assessed for the Improvement Provided for by Resolution of Intention to be Numbered 19," which said Diagram was approved by the Board of Trustees of said City of Lodi, on the 24th day of March, A. D. 1919, reference to which Diagram is hereby made for greater certainty.

And it is further ordered and notice is hereby given that serial bonds to represent unpaid assessments, and bear interest at the rate of seven per cent (7%) per annum will be issued hereunder in the manner provided by the Improvement Bond Act of 1915, and Acts Amendatory thereof, the last installment of which bonds shall mature nine years from the 2nd day of July, next succeeding nine months from their date.

This Resolution of Intention is adopted pursuant to the provisions of those certain Acts of the Legislature of the State of California, designated respectively as the "Improvement Act of 1911," and the "Improvement Bond Act of 1915" and Acts amendatory thereof and future proceedings hereunder shall be taken and had in accordance with the provisions of said Acts.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that on Monday, the 14th day of April, A. D. 1919, at 8 o'clock P. M. in the Council Chamber of the Board of Trustees, in the City Hall of said City of Lodi, any and all persons having any objection to the proposed work or improvement, may appear before said Board and show cause why said proposed improvement should not be carried out in accordance with this Resolution.

The Clerk of this Board of Trustees is hereby directed to cause this Resolution of Intention to be published three times in "The Lodi Sentinel," a tri-weekly newspaper published and circulated in said City and hereby designated for that purpose by the Board of Trustees; said newspaper being the official newspaper of said City of Lodi.

The Superintendent of Streets shall cause to be conspicuously posted along the line of said contemplated work and improvement and in front of all the property liable to be assessed, notice of the passage of this Resolution of Intention, in the manner and form required by law.
