RESOLUTION OF AWARD.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the City of Lodi did, in open session, on the 25th day of March, A. D. 1918, publicly open, examine and declare all sealed proposals or bids for doing certain street work in said city, under and in pursuance of the "Improvement Act of 1911," the names of the streets and highways proposed to be improved and the location and character of said proposed work being described in the Resolution of Intention No. 16 of said Board of Trustees, adopted February 11, 1918, which Resolution of Intention is hereby expressly referred to for further particulars.

RESOLVED, that the said Board of Trustees hereby reject all of said proposals or bids except that next herein mentioned, and hereby awards the contract for doing said work and improvement to the lowest responsible bidder, to-wit:

CLARK & HENRY CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, at the prices named in its bid.

The City Clerk is hereby directed to post notice of this award conspicuously for five days, on or near the chamber door of this Board of Trustees and also publish said notice twice in "The Lodi Sentinel," a tri-weekly newspaper published and circulated in said city, and hereby designated for that purpose by said Board.
