

Minutes Excerpt

City Hall, City of Lodi
Monday, April 5th., 1926.

After limited discussion by representatives of cement and asphaltic paving concerns as to their relative merits, the Board retired as Committee of the Whole to consider the type of pavement to be used in Lockeford Street and in the West end of Pine Street and on their return to the Council Chambers, the President announced that they had decided to continue with the asphaltic type and would adopt specifications therefore.

At this time Trustee Hale introduced Resolution of Intention No. 70 and the same was approved and adopted by the following vote:-
