

RESOLUTION.


WHEREAS, the City of Lodi did on the 4th. day of May 1908 vote bonds for the construction of a Sewer System for the disposal of the sewage of said city, and,

WHEREAS, that certain piece of real property, being outside the limits of said city, and situate in San Joaquin County, California, particularly described as follows, to-wit: "Beginning at the corner common to Sections Ten (10), Eleven (11), Fourteen (14), and Fifteen (15) in Township Three (3) North, Range Six (6) East of Mount Diablo Base and Meridian; and running thence along the South line of said Section Eleven (11) East 1839½ feet to the center of an irrigation canal for the point of beginning of the tract of land hereby conveyed; thence Northerly along the center line of said canal 974 feet; thence East 317.8 feet to the West side of a twenty foot lane; thence Southerly along the West side of said lane 974 feet to the South line of said Section Eleven (11); thence West along said Section line 322 feet to the point of beginning, and containing 7.22 acres, more or less, is necessary for Municipal purposes, to-wit: for the construction and maintenance of a Septic Tank as ~~an~~ a part of said sewer system in accordance with the plans accepted and approved by the Board of Trustees of said City, therefore,

Be It Resolved, that the said real property above described is necessary for the municipal purposes aforesaid, and G.E. Lawrence, the President of the Board of Trustees of the City of Lodi, is hereby authorized to do and perform ~~xxxxxxx~~ each and every act necessary for the purchase of said real property and to purchase and accept delivery of a deed for the same for and on behalf of said City, and on delivery of a good and sufficient deed for the said real property by H.H. Henderson, the owner thereof, to draw a warrant in favor of said H.H. Henderson for the sum of \$ 1400.00, which sum the Board of Trustees hereby finds to be a reasonable and just price for the same.

The foregoing resolution was at an adjourned regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the City of Lodi held on the 7th. day of April, 1910 duly passed by the affirmative votes of Trustees J.M. Blodgett, F.O. Hale, G.E. Lawrence, C.A. Rich and L. Villinger.
