

WHEREAS, The Lodi Chapter of the American Red Cross contemplates the establishment of a salvage department in the City of Lodi, where waste articles of every description may be collected and turned into money for the aid of the American soldiers and sailors in France; therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the offices and departments of the City government are requested to co-operate with the salvage department of the American Red Cross by arranging to turn over to them such waste articles as may be of value to them.

The above resolution was introduced at a regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the City of Lodi, held Monday, May 20th, 1918, and was regularly adopted by the following vote:
