

RESOLUTION GRANTING PERMISSION TO THE FRANK H. BUCK COMPANY
TO EXTEND A SPUR TRACK SWITCH IN THE CITY OF LODI.

WHEREAS, the Frank H. Buck Company has made a request for a permit to move and extend the spur track switch located on Main Street in the City of Lodi to a point 130 feet south of its present location, and as more clearly defined and shown on the attached blue print, extension of said track being for the purpose of better serving its industrial site, and it appearing that said extension of said switch will not interfere with the transaction of other business in this locality; therefore be it

RESOLVED, by the City Trustees of the City of Lodi that a permit be, and it is hereby, granted to the said Frank H. Buck Company to move said switch connect ion one hundred and thirty (130) feet south of its present location, said permit being granted upon condition that this Board reserves the right to revoke this permit at any time.
