RESOLUTION OF AWARD 407

WASHINGTON STREET

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the City of Lodi did, in open session on the 2nd day of July, A.D. 1923, publicly open, examine and declare all sealed proposals or bids for doing certain street work in said City, under and pursuant of the "Improvement Act of 1911", the names of the streets and highways proposed to be improved and the location and character of said proposed work and the district to be assessed therefore being described in the Resolution of Intention No. 63, which Resolution of Intention is hereby expressly referred to for further particulars.

RESOLVED, that the said Board of Trustees hereby rejects all of said proposals or bids except the next herein mentioned, and hereby awards the contract for doing the said work and improvement to the lowest responsible bidder, viz: -CLARK & HENRY CONSTRUCTION COMPANY at the prices named in its bid. The City Clerk is hereby directed to post notices of this award conspicuously for five days, on or near the chamber door of this Board of Trustees and also publish said notice three times in "the Lodi News", a tri-weekly newspaper published and circulated in said city and hereby designated for said purpose by said Board.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that notice be given and is hereby given that serial bonds to represent unpaid assessments and bear interest at the rate of seven (7) per cent per annum, will be issued hereunder in the manner provided by the Improvement Bond Act of 1915, the last installment of which bonds mature nine months from the 2nd day of July next succeeding nine months from their date
