

WHEREAS, this Board of Trustees did on the 5th day of June, A. D. 1916, pass a resolution declaring its intention to order certain work to be done and improvements made, namely, to open an alley running from Hutchins Street to Pleasant Avenue, through that certain block of Ayres and Pitchers Addition to Lodi, which is bounded on the North by Lockeford Street, on the East by Pleasant Avenue, on the South by Locust Street, and on the West by Hutchins Street; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to said resolution, and the Act of the Legislature of the State of California followed in this matter, to-wit, the Act of March 6, 1889, Statutes of 1889, Page 70 et seq, and the amendments thereto, H. B. Coleman, the Street Superintendent of the City of Lodi, caused to be conspicuously posted along the line of said contemplated work or improvement, at not more than 300 feet in distance apart, *Eight* notices of the passage of said resolution, which said notices were headed "Notice of Public Work", in letters not less than one inch in length, in legible characters, and stated the fact of the passage of the resolution, its date and approval, the work or improvement proposed, and referred to the resolution for further particulars, all of which will more fully appear from the affidavit of said H. B. Coleman, the said Street Superintendent on file with the Clerk of this Board; and,

WHEREAS, said H. B. Coleman, as said Street Superintendent, did cause a notice similar in substance to be published for the time and in the manner prescribed by said Statute, as will more fully appear from the affidavit of publication of said notice, on file with the Clerk of this Board; and,

WHEREAS, more than ten days have expired since the last publication of said notice, and no objections to said work or improvement, either written or otherwise, have been delivered to the Clerk of this Board, and this Board having acquired jurisdiction as provided in said Statute,-

NOW, THEREFORE, this Board of Trustees does now order that said

work described in said resolution of intention, and in said notice of public work so posted and published, be done, and _____

August Soucie, J. E. Hopkins
and M. P. Lancaster are hereby appointed as commissioners to assess benefits and damages and have general supervision of the proposed work and improvement until the completion thereof, in compliance with said Statute. For their services they shall receive such compensation as this Board may determine from time to time, and such compensation shall be added to and chargeable as a part of the expenses of the work and improvement.

I hereby certify that the above resolution was introduced and read at a regular meeting of the Board of Trustees of the City of Lodi, held on the 7th day of August, 1916, and was, on the same date, regularly adopted by the following vote:
