A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF LODI SUPPLEMENTING RESOLUTION NO. 826
ADOPTED JANUARY 6, 1936, DESIGNATING CERTAIN
STREETS AS "STREETS OF MAJOR IMPORTANCE"
(SECTION 195, STREETS AND HIGHWAYS CODE)

RESOLVED, that the Resolution named in the title
hereof be amended and supplemented so that the following named
street within the corporate limits of the City of Lodi, County
of San Joaquin, between the termini indicated herein, be selected,
approved and designated by this City Council of the City of Lodi
as a "STREET OF MAJOR IMPORTANCE".

NAME

TERMINI AND DESCRIPTION

A street eighty feet in width,
East and West and extending South-
erly from State Highway 24, (Lodi
to San Andreas), to Pppe Avenue,
(commonly known as East Pine Street)
the westerly line of which is
1,268 feet easterly from the East
line of State Highway No. 4.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this City Council hereby
recommends to the Department of Public Works of the State of
California, that the above named and described street be like-
wise approved by the Director of said department as a "STREET
OF MAJOR IMPORTANCE" in the City of Lodi.
