WHEREAS, The City Attorney has made certain recommendations in regard to interest on city money heretofore deposited in bank by the City Treasurer; and,

WHEREAS, this board has given the matter careful and thorough consideration and deem that all matters considered and under the circumstances the sum of \$1050.00 is a fair and reasonable sum to be accepted by the City of Lodi in payment of interest on such deposits; now therefore be it

RESOLVED, That said sum of \$1050.00 be and it is hereby accepted by this Board in full payment of all interest on said deposits.
