

In The Board of Trustees of the City of Lodi, California.

RESOLUTION NO. 509.

WHEREAS, the City of Lodi did, by deed recorded April 19th., 1926, acquire from R. P. Barbour and from Mary C. Barbour, his wife certain property in Ayers & Pitchers addition to Lodi described as follows:-

"A parcel of land located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 2, T 3 N, R 6 E to be used as a public street by the City of Lodi, California, Commencing for the same at a point on the South line of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 2, T 3 N, R 6 E distant 344.8 ft West of the SE corner of said $\frac{1}{4}$ Section and running thence North 280.2 ft to a point on the South line of Lockeford Street, thence West along said South line of Lockeford Street 60.1 ft. to a point on the same; thence South 283.7 ft to a point on the South line of said $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 2, thence on and along said South line 60.1 ft to the point of beginning."

AND WHEREAS, said land or the major portion thereof was assessed and taxed in the County of San Joaquin in the name of Josephine Jopp, the record owner as of March 1st., 1926 and the taxes on the same are now due and payable;

AND WHEREAS, said land or the major portion thereof is not liable for sale or for any tax liens on behalf of Said County of San Joaquin, being now the property of said City and dedicated and used for the purposes of a public road;

Be it Resolved by the Board of Trustees of the City of Lodi: that the President of this Board be, and he is hereby instructed to petition the Board of Supervisors of said San Joaquin County for a cancellation of said tax and assessment

Be it Also Resolved: That the City Attorney be instructed to explain this matter to the District Attorney of said San Joaquin County and secure his approval to the said cancellation of said tax and assessment as provided in Section 3804-a of the ~~Code~~ Political Code of this State.

Gentlemen:-

The undersigned, on behalf of the Board of Trustees of the City of Lodi, San Joaquin County, California, thereunto authorized by resolution of said Board passed and adopted on Monday, the 7th. day of March, 1927, respectfully asks that your Honorable Board cancel the assessment and tax levied thereunder against the following described property now the property of said City of Lodi, viz:-

Tax Rec. No. 15331 Assessed to Josephine Jopp
In Ayers & Pitchers Addition to Lodi particularly described as follows: Commencing on the North line of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sect. 2 T 3 N R 6 E 321 ft East of the NE corner of said SE $\frac{1}{4}$ and running thence Northerly along the West line of land formerly owned by E. E. Tucker, 309 ft to the center line of Lockeford Street, thence Westerly along said center line 85 ft. to the NE corner of land formerly owned by Albert Pate; thence Southerly along the Easterly line of said Pate's land, 314 ft. to the North line of said SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sect. 2; thence East along said last named line, 85 ft. to beginning

Petitioner recites that said land is now the City of Lodi and is now used and dedicated as a public street and that as property of said City, the same is not liable to sale for delinquent taxes and that any lien that may be attached to said property for said taxes is unenforceable.

Wherefore petitioner requests that this assessment and tax be cancelled in the manner provided by Sect. 3804-a of the Political Code of the State of California.
