

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE WORK TO BE DONE UNDER THE DIRECTION OF THE CITY
ENGINEER AND ASSESSMENT TO BE MADE BY HIM.

No. 636-A

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Lodi, did, on the 13th day of April, 1931, pass its Resolution of Intention No. 72 to order certain work to be done and improvement to be made bordering on said City, which Resolution of Intention is hereby expressly referred to for further particulars, and said City Council did thereafter on the 29th day of April, 1931, duly pass its Resolution Ordering the Work No. 636, ordering said work to be done and said improvement to be made bordering on said City, which Resolution Ordering the Work is also hereby referred to for further particulars; and

WHEREAS the plans and specifications for doing said work and making said improvement have heretofore been adopted by said City Council and are now on file in the office of the City Clerk of said City, and are hereby referred to for further particulars; and

WHEREAS, said City Council desires that said work be done under the direction of the City Engineer of said City; and

WHEREAS, said City Council desires that the assessment hereafter to be made in the proceeding shall be made and signed by the City Engineer instead of the Superintendent of Streets; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Lodi that it direct, and it does hereby direct, that the aforesaid work shall be done under the direction of the City Engineer of said City and the materials used shall comply with said specifications and be to the satisfaction of said City engineer, instead of the Superintendent of Streets of said City of Lodi; and it does hereby further direct and provide that the assessment hereafter to be made in the proceeding shall be made and signed by the City Engineer instead of the Superintendent of Streets.


