RESOLUTION NO. 739

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN AN APPLICATION
FOR APPROVAL OF EMERGENCY RELIEF ADMINISTRATION PROJECT.

WHEREAS, this City Council deems it to be for the best interests of this City that application be made to the State Emergency Relief Administration to do certain work, viz: THE EXTENSION OF EXISTING SANITARY AND/OR INDUSTRIAL SEWER LINES OVER PUBLIC STREETS AND CITY EASEMENTS TO SERVE PROPERTIES ON SOUTH GARFIELD STREET, SOUTH OF VINE STREET; ON STOCKTON STREET, SOUTH OF TOKAY AND ON SOUTH SCHOOL STREET, SOUTH OF SPRUCE STREET, and it is now desired to make application for said project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that application for said project be so made to the State Emergency Relief Administration for California, and that the Mayor be, and he is hereby authorized to sign said application for and on behalf of this City;

BE IT ALSO RESOLVED, that JOHN A. HENNING, Superintendent of Public Utilities of this City be, and he is hereby designated as the person who will supervise said project in the event of its approval by the Emergency Relief Administration.

In recommending this project to the Emergency Relief Administration, this Council calls attention to the fact that the City of Lodi has never made sewer installations and/or extensions by direct assessment against the property benefitted, all of said installations having been made from General Fund moneys.
