WHEREAS, this City Council of the City of Lodi, County of San Joaquin, State of California approves and endorses the Federal Housing Administration's campaign as undertaken by the local committee on better housing but no provision has been heretofore made in the budget for funds necessary to carry out the purposes of said campaign;

BE IT RESOLVED, that application be hereby made to the State Emergency Relief Administration for assistance in furnishing solicitors to canvass the householders of the City of Lodi to make repairs, alterations and construction of buildings as is contemplated by the Federal Housing Administration;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor of this City be, and he is hereby authorized to sign such application for and on behalf of this City, and that the permanent chairman of the local better housing campaign committee be and he is hereby designated as the person who will supervise said work and project in the event of its approval by the Emergency Relief Administration
