RESOLUTION NO. 830

WHEREAS, this City Council deems it to be for the best interest of the City of Lodi that certain streets hereinafter named or described be opened between the terminals also herein named.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Attorney and the City Engineer be and they are hereby authorized and directed to take the necessary steps to extend Concord Street from Central Avenue to the Westerly line of Lot 40 of the Lodi Barnhart Tract and to open Washington Street from the Southerly line of Vine Street to the North line of Lot 41 in said Lodi Barnhart Tract; and to open a roadway 40 feet in width extending 20 feet on each side of the Northern boundary line of Lot 40 between Central Avenue and Washington Street extended and to open Watson Street to a width of 40 feet from Central Avenue to Stockton Avenue; and to open Maple Street from Garfield Street to Cherokee Lane, all such streets and avenues being located in the Lodi Barnhart Tract as per the official map of the same.

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The foregoing Resolution No. 830 was regularly passed and adopted at a regular meeting of the City Council held January 20, 1936 by the following vote:
