

RESOLUTION NO. 2011-125

A RESOLUTION OF THE LODI CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING  
CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AND SUBMIT NECESSARY  
PAPERWORK AND CLAIM FORMS FOR ALL PROJECTS  
FUNDED BY MEASURE K COMPETITIVE AND NON-  
COMPETITIVE BICYCLE PROJECTS

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WHEREAS, the voters of San Joaquin County approved Measure K, which provides funding for transportation system improvements through a one-half cent retail sales tax; and

WHEREAS, one categorical allocation under Measure K is the Bicycle, Pedestrian and Safe Routes to School Program; and

WHEREAS, this funding category provides both competitive and non-competitive funding for new bikeways construction projects, including design, planning and implementation studies; and

WHEREAS, the San Joaquin Council of Governments requires a Resolution authorizing the City Manager to sign claim forms on behalf of the City of Lodi; and

WHEREAS, the City of Lodi will use their allocated Measure K Competitive and Non-Competitive Bicycle, Pedestrian and Safe Routes to School Program funds to fund new bikeways construction projects, including design, planning and implementation studies.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Lodi City Council does hereby authorize the City Manager to execute and submit necessary paperwork and claim forms for all projects funded by the Measure K Competitive and Non-Competitive Bicycle, Pedestrian and Safe Routes to School Program.
