

RESOLUTION NO. 2012-197

A RESOLUTION OF THE LODI CITY COUNCIL
APPROVING PURCHASE OF SOLIDS THICKENER
EQUIPMENT FOR WHITE SLOUGH WATER
POLLUTION CONTROL FACILITY

WHEREAS, the original solids thickener equipment was installed in 1967 when White Slough Water Pollution Control Facility was built. It operated until 1991 when the plant expanded and a new, larger thickener was installed, and the original thickener was abandoned; and

WHEREAS, flows have increased since 1991, and the need for greater solids-thickening capacity has also increased. The most economical solution for increasing solids-thickening capacity is to retrofit the original unused thickener with new and up-to-date equipment; and

WHEREAS, Tenco-Hydro, Inc., is the sole-source equipment manufacturer that designed and built the original thickener, and its equipment requires no special construction; and

WHEREAS, per Lodi Municipal Code Section 3.20.070, Bidding, the bidding process may be dispensed when City Council determines that the purchase or method of purchase is in the best interests of the City; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends purchase of the solids thickener equipment from Tenco-Hydro, Inc.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Lodi City Council does hereby approve the purchase of solids thickener equipment for White Slough Water Pollution Control Facility from Tenco-Hydro, Inc., of Brookfield, Illinois, in the amount of \$193,000.
