

**INTRODUCTION**

Federal transit Administration does not require transit agencies provide free fare to a Personal Care Attendant (PCA) when they accompany a person with a disability using the fixed route transit services. At the December 18, 2013, City Council adopted the following policy allowing free fare for PCAs:

**POLICY**

This policy allows PCAs to travel for free on the City of Lodi's GrapeLine fixed route service when accompanying a passenger holding a discounted fare card and approved for assistance by a PCA. Only one PCA per passenger is allowed and other guests will be charged the appropriate fare.
