

RESOLUTION NO. 2014-74

A RESOLUTION OF THE LODI CITY COUNCIL AWARDING AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE CONTRACT FOR THE AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT IMPROVEMENT PROJECT PHASE 3 – CHURCH STREET PARKING LOTS AND FURTHER APPROPRIATING FUNDS

WHEREAS, in answer to notice duly published in accordance with law and the order of this City Council, sealed bids were received and publicly opened on April 10, 2014, at 11:00 a.m., for the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Improvement Project Phase 3 – Church Street Parking Lots, described in the plans and specifications therefore approved by the City Council on March 5, 2014; and

WHEREAS, said bids have been checked and tabulated and a report thereof filed with the City Manager as follows:

WHEREAS, the low bidder, MCI Engineering, has signed the required Local Hire forms and will conform to the requirements; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends awarding the contract for the ADA Improvement Project Phase 3 – Church Street Parking Lots, to the low bidder, MCI Engineering, of Stockton, California, in the amount of \$278,926.32.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Lodi City Council does hereby award the contract for the ADA Improvement Project Phase 3 – Church Street Parking Lots, to the low bidder, MCI Engineering, of Stockton, California, in the amount of \$278,926.32; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute the contract; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that funds in the amount of \$47,000 be appropriated for the project from the General Fund Capital account.
